

# The Perioperative Hand Off Protocol

#### Hand off Team Members

- Anesthesia provider
- Surgeon/Fellow/Resident/PA
- Intensivist/Resident
- ICU Nurse
- OR Nurse
- **Respiratory Therapist**



## **Pre-Handoff:**

## OR Nurse:

Call Receiving ICU Nurse OR 24-8147 with:

- ✓ Procedure
- ✓ Lines/Access
  ✓ Drips/Pressors
- ✓ Ventilator status

## ICU Nurse:

✓ Notify ICU resident prior to patient arrival

# **Handoff:**

## Start: Patient enters room

#### **1.** Anesthesia provider

- ✓ Announces patient's name
- Says his/her name
- ✓ Identifies accepting ICU provider, RN and
- Prompts start of monitor-line setup
- ✓ Continues directing care until handoff is complete

# 2. Monitor-line setup

DO NOT start report until:

- ✓ Nurse completes monitor-line setup
- ✓ Full attention of team and all members are present

# **3.** Surgeon/Fellow/Resident gives report

- ✓ Follow checklist
- End by sharing what worries you most about this patient

# **4.** Anesthesia provider gives report

- ✓ Follow checklist
- End by sharing what worries you the most about this patient

# **5.** ICU provider and nurse

- ✓ Ask any questions
- Clarify remaining issues
- ✓ Announce: "Hand off is now complete"

## End: Providers may leave bedside
