

Anesthesia Preprocedure Navigator uses Widescreen View

The Preprocedure navigator now uses **widescreen view**:

- The screen is now divided into **two panels** with the Section Names (**1** and **2**) displayed at the **top** of each panel.
- The **arrows** at the **bottom** (**3**) **expand** either the left or right panel width.
- You can also use the **mouse** to **manually** expand either panel (**4**).
