

Anesthesia Multiple Procedures Tip Sheet

When a single patient anesthetic spans multiple procedures, the system can now consolidate anesthesia information and simplify the documentation process. As a result, clinicians can see and manage all procedures linked to an anesthesia record in one place.



Try It Out

1. In the Status Board or Patient Station, open the anesthesia record for patient that has multiple procedures scheduled.
2. In the anesthesia pre-op activity, there is an Attached Procedures section. Multiple cases and procedures will be available to be attached to one anesthesia record. This allows for more accurate documentation of a patients' anesthetic encounter, and will reduce the number of ad hoc encounters during a visit.
