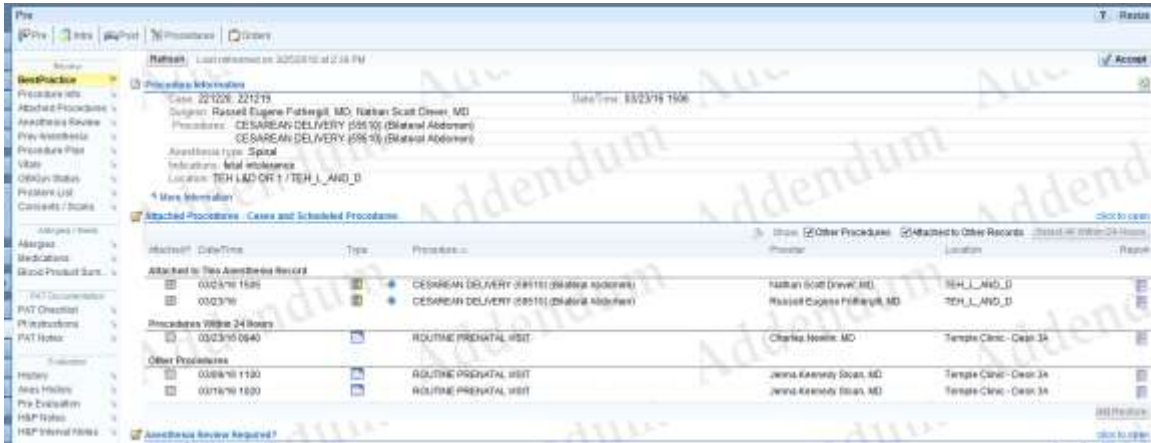


Notes on fixing Attached Procedures Errors:

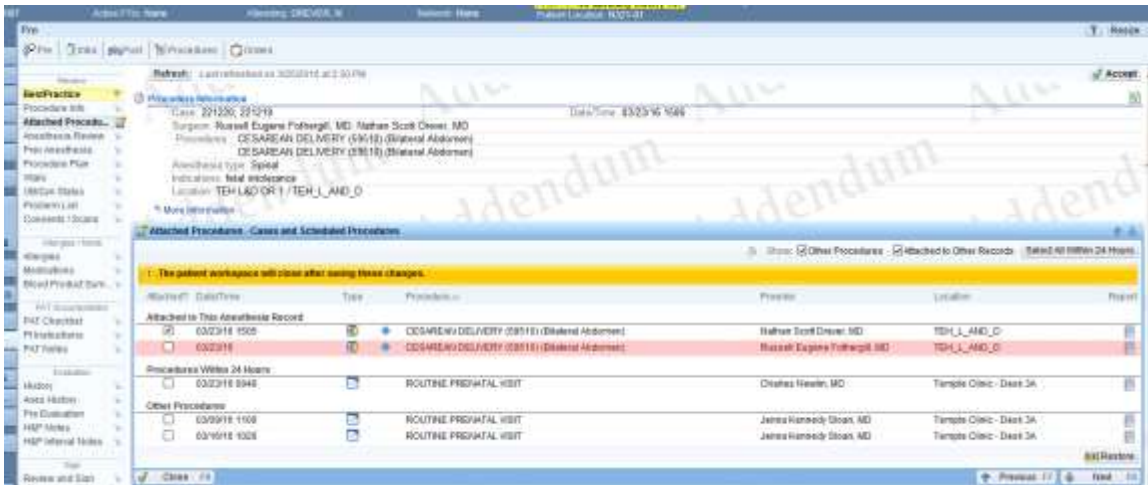
Open the Anesthesia Record (Patient Station is a good way) as an Addendum.
Open the “Pre” Tab (as shown below):



Here, you can see in both the Procedure Information and Attached Procedures sections that this Anesthesia Record has TWO C-section entries attached to it.

To correct this, open the Attached Procedures section of the Navigator.
(double click in the blue text section heading or in the left column section heading)

Then click or unclick to select only the correct procedure (in this instance Dr. Drever's case).



Then Close (F9) the Attached Procedures section (use the button in the left lower corner).
The Anesthesia Record Addendum will close automatically.

Sometimes the “correct” surgical procedure will already have a partial Anesthesia log (case record) opened and attached to it. That partial case will have to be deleted by an Anesthesia Record Administrator.
